The SNIM Foundation was established in 2007 as a sign of the commitment of the National Industrial and Mining Company (SNIM) to local development. It is currently recognized as a public utility association, whose main mission is to manage and implement SNIM's initiatives in favor of the populations living along the railway corridor linking

Zouerate to Nouadhibou, as well as in the Birmoghrein region and on a national scale.

The Foundation operates as a public utility organization in accordance with its statutes and aims to achieve its objectives defined by its board of directors which is mandated to oversee all its programs and projects.

The Foundation works in harmony and close collaboration with all stakeholders, particularly local authorities, who act as its primary partners, representing citizens and expressing their needs and priorities within the framework of national strategies for health, literacy, and poverty alleviation adopted by the Government. In all its endeavors, it strives to generate lasting benefits for the populations by implementing beneficial development projects that have a direct impact on people's lives and livelihoods.

As part of the local development program, most of the Foundation's recent initiatives have focused on maintenance, expansion, and rehabilitation works, primarily in response to the demands of local stakeholders.

INSTITUTIONAL FRAMEWORK

The SNIM Foundation is a non-political, non-union, and nonprofit association established in 2007 for an unlimited duration. It has independent legal and administrative status as well as financial management autonomy.

It was declared a public utility association in 2012, a distinction that enables it to benefit from assistance and support from administrative authorities in accordance with regulations governing recognized public utility associations.

The Foundation aims to be a genuine instrument serving sustainable development at the local and national levels by undertaking the following missions :

- Identify investment opportunities in the localities along the Nouadhibou -Zouerate railway corridor.
- Highlight local growth potential and promising sectors capable of generating substantial and sustainable employment and income.
- Collaborate with each concerned municipality in developing a comprehensive development plan.
- Participate in the design, implementation, and monitoring of integrated development projects in collaboration with local communities' leaders and grassroots communities.
- Assist in mobilizing necessary resources for project financing.
- Support the socio-economic reinsertion of SNIM's retirees living within its operational area.
- Facilitate access to microcredit for the populations concerned.
- Promote entrepreneurship by supporting projects holders.
- Develop exchanges on best practices in poverty alleviation.
- Forge strategic alliances with similar entities, particularly development foundations at the national and international levels.

FOUNDATION VISION

The Foundation Vision is ambitious and forward-looking, aiming to become the undisputed and nationally recognized leader in the field of social and economic development. This vision is founded on the principles of innovation, sustainability, and excellence across all its initiatives.

It seeks to catalyze social and economic progress, act as a driver of positive change, and exemplify a holistic approach to development. For this purpose, the Foundation strives to establish strong partnerships, implement

innovative programs, and continues fostering inclusive growth while adhering to principles of accountability and transparency.

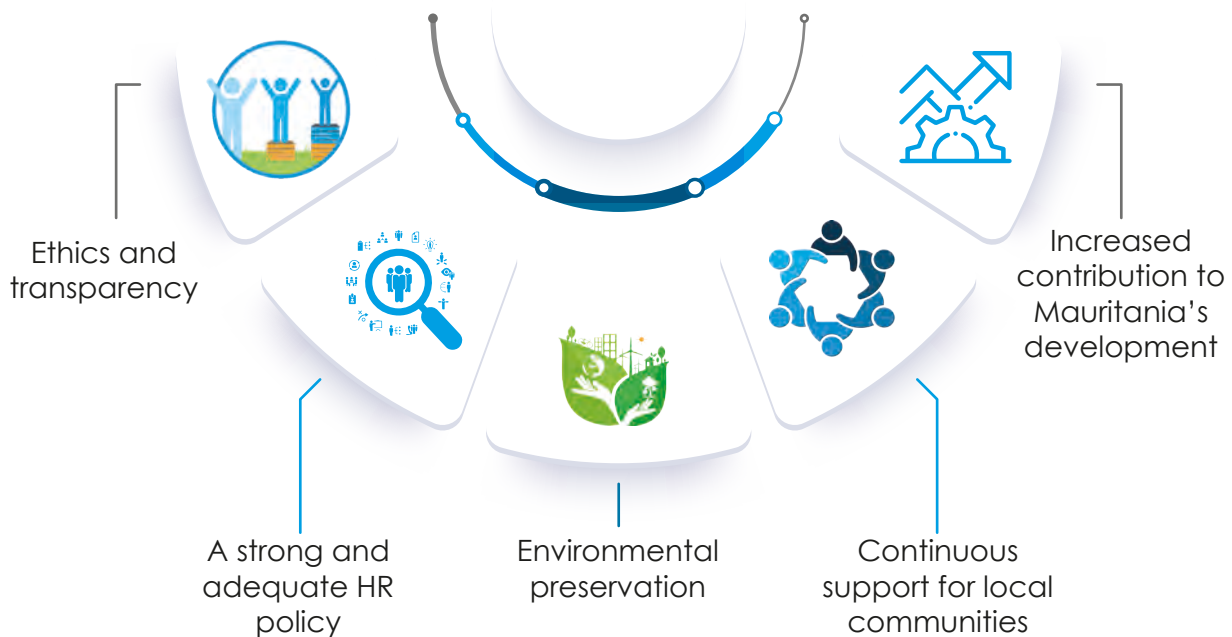




THE FOUNDATION : A LEVER FOR SNIM'S CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY (CSR)

its employees, communities, and the environment. This responsibility strategy is structured around five main axes :

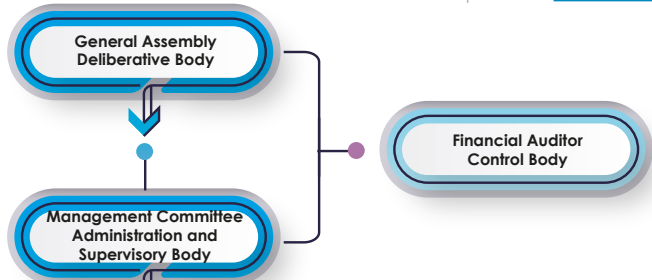

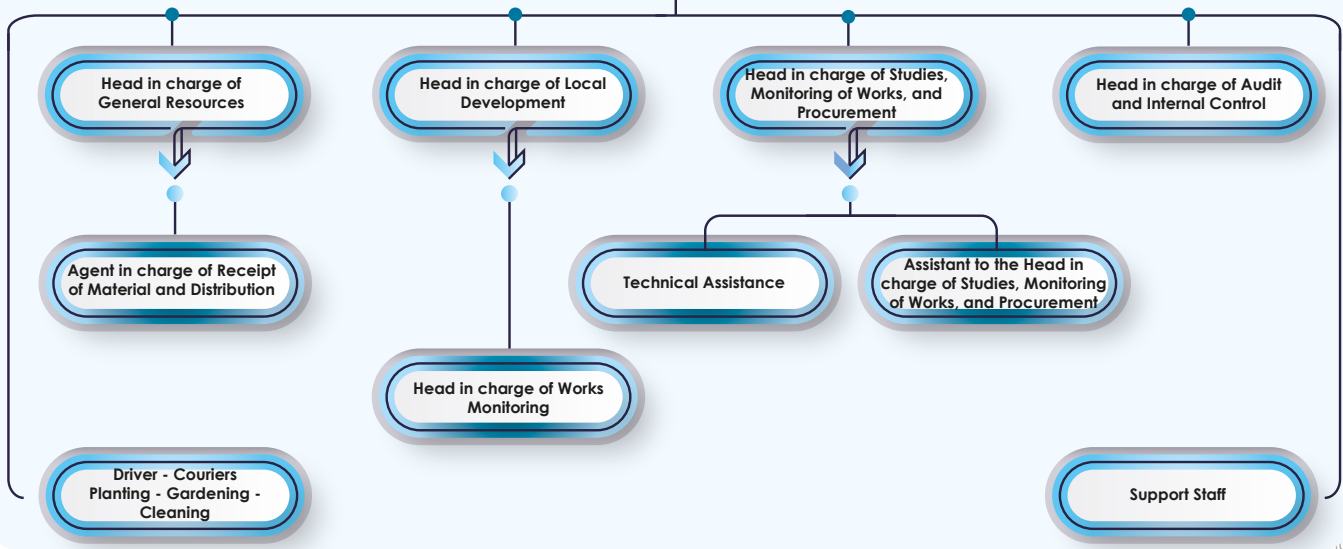
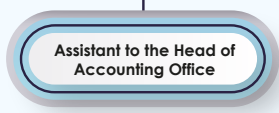
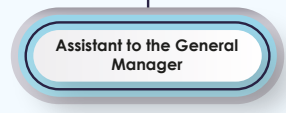
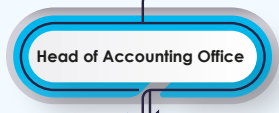
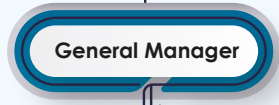
FOUNDATION GOVERNANCE SYSTEM

The governance system of the SNIM Foundation is built on several key characteristics that ensure the necessary conditions for effective and responsible management :

- **Transparency and accountability:** Transparency in decision-making and communication of financial and operational activities is fundamental. The Foundation annually reports its accounts to stakeholders, notably to SNIM Company.
- **A management committee** composed of competent members with diverse profiles, bringing varied and complementary skills. These members act in the Foundation's best interest, possessing in-depth knowledge of philanthropy and targeted sectors.
- **Clarity in mission and objectives:** The Foundation has clearly defined missions and objectives. The governance system, through the general assembly and control bodies, ensures all foundation activities align with these objectives and contribute to their achievement.
- **Ethics and compliance:** Adherence to ethical standards, compliance with laws and regulations, and the adoption of good governance practices ensure the foundation's reputation and integrity.
- **Monitoring and evaluation:** The Foundation has developed an effective monitoring and evaluation system for its activities, enabling the measurement of progress, identification of areas for improvement, and adjustment of strategies accordingly.
- **Engagement with stakeholders:** The Foundation tirelessly continues to involve stakeholders, including SNIM Company, beneficiaries, partners, and the community in decision-making and activities planning.

GOVERNANCE BODIES

General Assembly

The General Assembly of the Foundation consists of a single member: SNIM. It establishes the overall policy and organizational principles and management of the institution. It appoints the members of the Management Committee, totaling 5 members, chaired by the Managing Director of SNIM. It also appoints the Financial Auditor.

Management Committee

The Management Committee meets at least 4 times a year. It appoints the General Manager of the Foundation. It sets the strategic directions of the institution and ensures its proper management. It selects and approves projects to be implemented under the budget and monitors the corresponding accounts.

General Management

A permanent team of 10 staff, led by the General Manager of the Foundation, ensures the implementation of the General Assembly's policy, manages the Foundation, oversees project progress, and handles relationships with third parties.

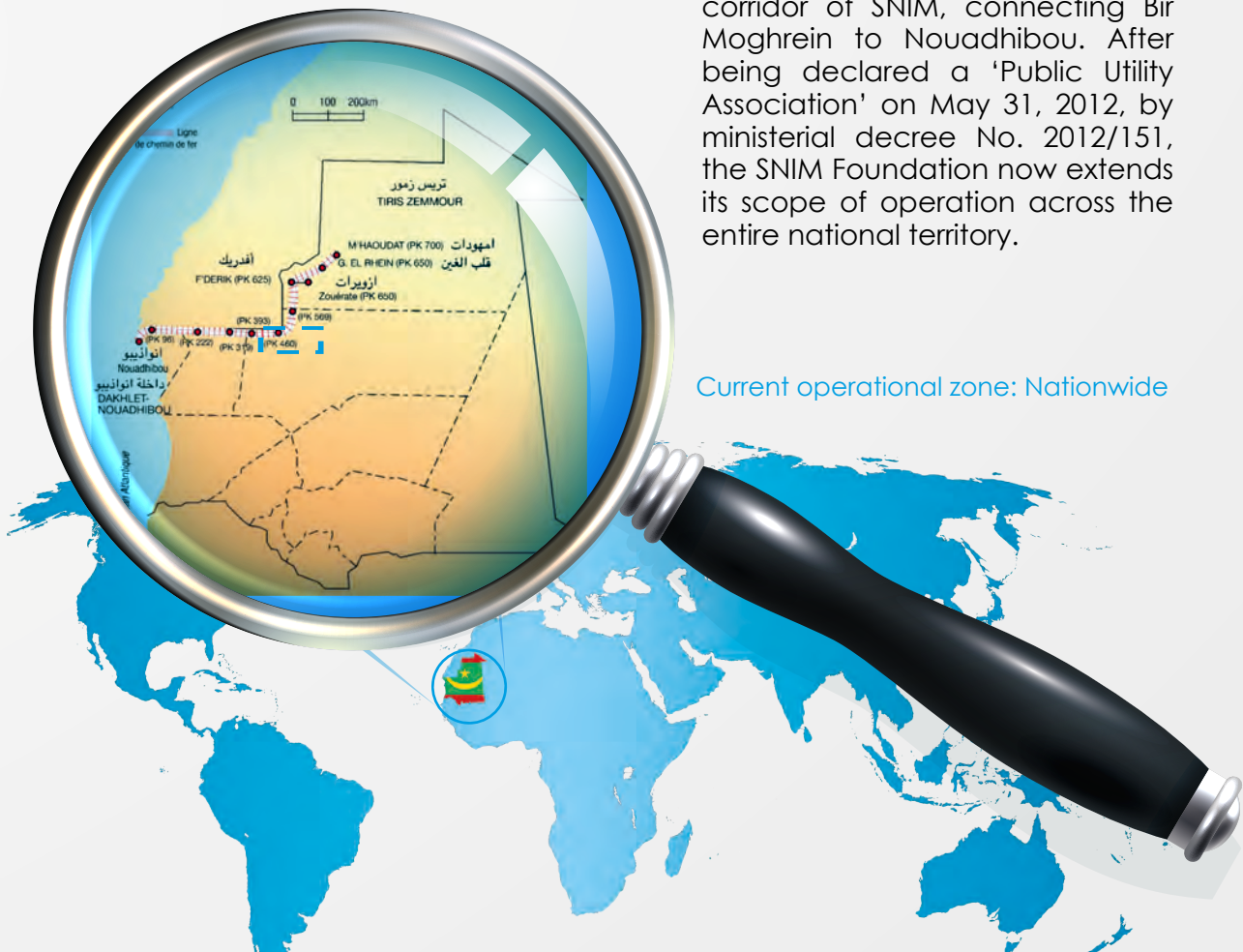
They actively drive the Foundation's daily operations.

Financial Auditor

The Auditor is appointed by the General Assembly, as an oversight body, among professionals from the National Order of Chartered Accountants for the legal certification of annual financial statements. They are appointed for a renewable three-year term and are obligated to report to the General Assembly and the Management Committee.

EVOLUTION OF THE FOUNDATION'S AREAS OF OPERATIONS

The Foundation's initial intervention area covered the activity corridor of SNIM, connecting Bir Moghrein to Nouadhibou. After being declared a 'Public Utility Association' on May 31, 2012, by ministerial decree No. 2012/151, the SNIM Foundation now extends its scope of operation across the entire national territory.

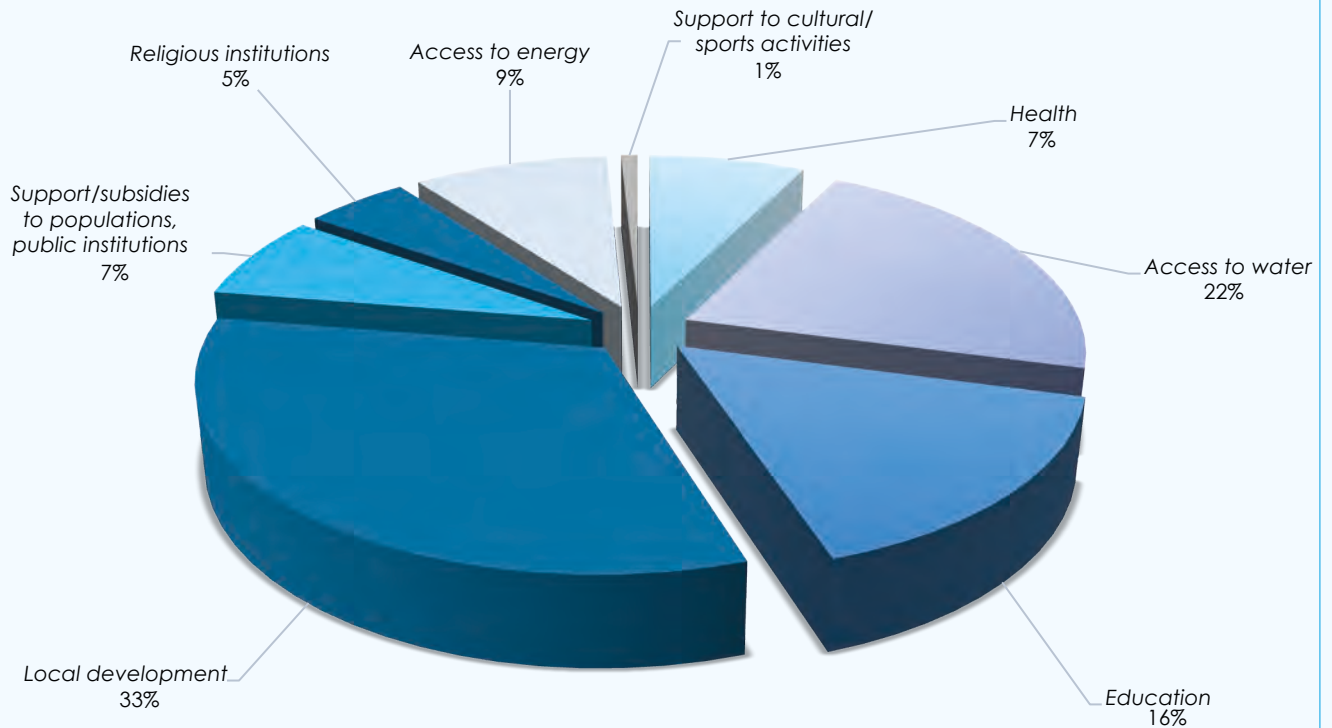

This table presents the commitments of the SNIM Foundation in various sectors since its creation in 2007. Based on this data, the following aspects should be highlighted :

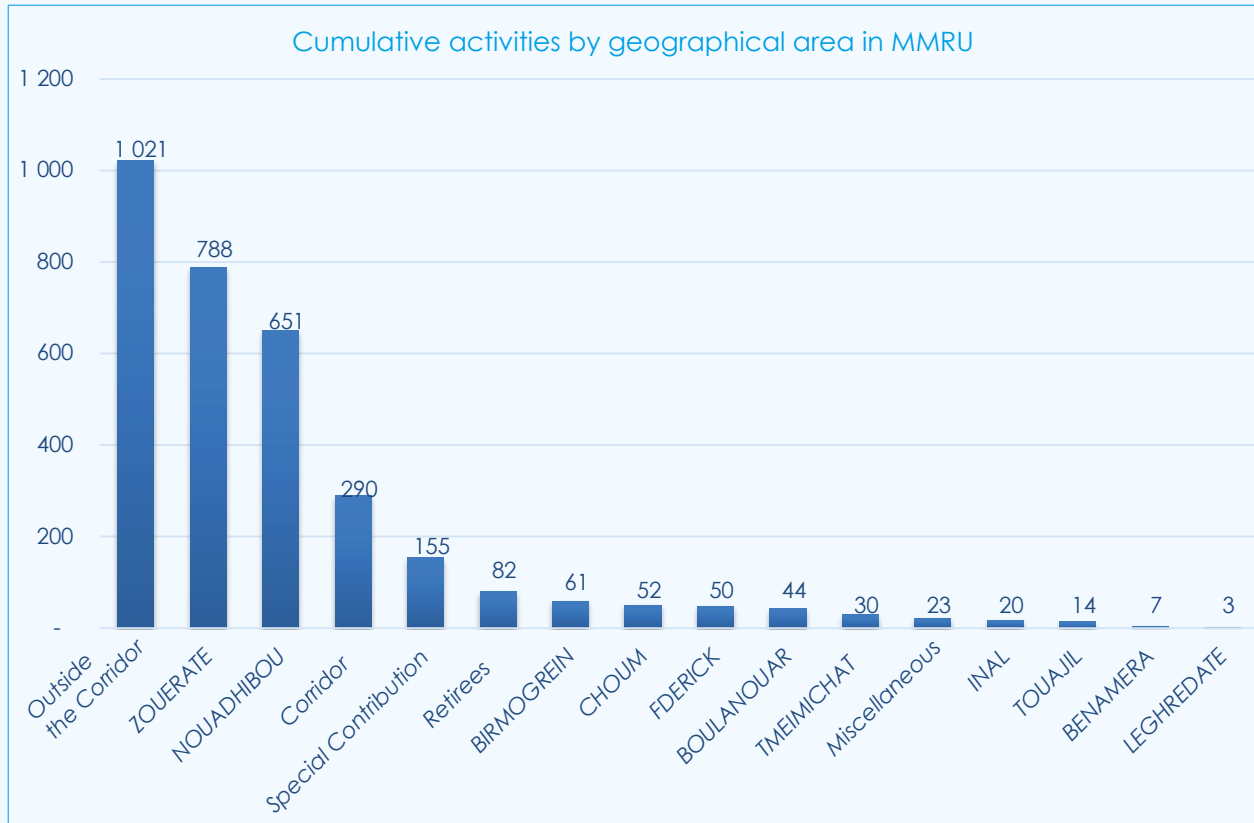
- Evolution of Foundation Commitments: Significant variation in investments has been noted in different areas of activity from one year to another. Some sectors have shown consistent growth, while others have been more volatile and experienced significant fluctuations such as health and water.
- Priority Areas: Health and access to water received the most financial support, with substantial amounts allocated, highlighting the importance placed on these key sectors.
- Diversity of Interventions: The Foundation covers a wide range of areas, including education, local development, food security, support for cultural/sports activities, etc. This suggests a diversified approach to meet the varied needs of communities.
- Contribution to SDGs: These interventions are aligned with several United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), notably health (SDG 3), clean water and sanitation (SDG 6), quality education (SDG 4), and reduced inequalities (SDG 10).

FIVE FUNDAMENTAL COMMITMENTS

The SNIM Foundation structures its programs around five fundamental commitments, thus contributing to efforts aimed at achieving the main Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs):

Access to basic social services (water, electricity, healthcare, education, etc.) for targeted populations, prioritizing the use of renewable energies and processes that respect environmental preservation as much as possible.



2022 : KEY EVENTS

The year 2022 marks an important turning point in the Foundation's programs. The transformations initiated during this year are all aimed at achieving the efficiency

- Strengthening the Foundation's human resources with additional skills provided by SNIM.
- Implementation of a new version of the management procedures manual.
- Migration to a new integrated information system (SAP B1).
- Conducting a Benchmark study by the consulting firm ENCO on successful experiences of similar Foundations worldwide. An action plan for implementing the recommendations of this study will be submitted for validation to the Foundation's Management Committee.
- Start of works for the construction of the new premises of the Foundation

and results on the ground and for a better impact on improving the living conditions of targeted populations.

in the city center in December 2022. The new ergonomic and functional building (Groundfloor+1) will meet the needs of its operational services in terms of workspace and, on the other hand, allow for better proximity to stakeholders (administrations, populations, etc.).

- Taking care of the management, maintenance, and guarding of all boreholes drilled, in accordance with the recommendations of the Foundation's Management Committee regarding the proper functioning and sustainability of the facilities.

BUDGET ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2022

At the end of the fiscal year 2022, the planned activities reached a commitment level of %74, representing a total amount of MRU493.97 million. This percentage reflects significant progress in budget achievements despite the delay

in budget approval. Consequently, the implementation of planned activities continues beyond the initial period, demonstrating continuous monitoring of projects (Annex 1).

ACTIVITY SUMMARY BY SECTOR

The year 2022 witnessed a remarkable increase in expenses in the community development sector, totaling MRU161.3 million, representing 32.31% of budgetary commitments. This prioritization of community development reflects our commitment to improving the living conditions of local populations.

Furthermore, significant efforts have also been made in the areas of water access and education, representing respectively 21.35% and 15.51% of commitments. These sectors continue to receive special attention in our development approach, highlighting their importance in promoting social well-being and good quality education.

Support for local development

In 2022, a budget of MRU 161.3 million was allocated for local development support in the railway corridor. This budget represents approximately 33% of the total budget for 2022 and includes the following initiatives :

- Development of infrastructure in the city of Zouerate.
- Annual support for SNIM retirees' cooperatives in Nouadhibou and Zouerate, as well as other cooperatives in the municipalities of Nouadhibou and Choum.
- Provision of equipment for the communal training center in F'Derick.

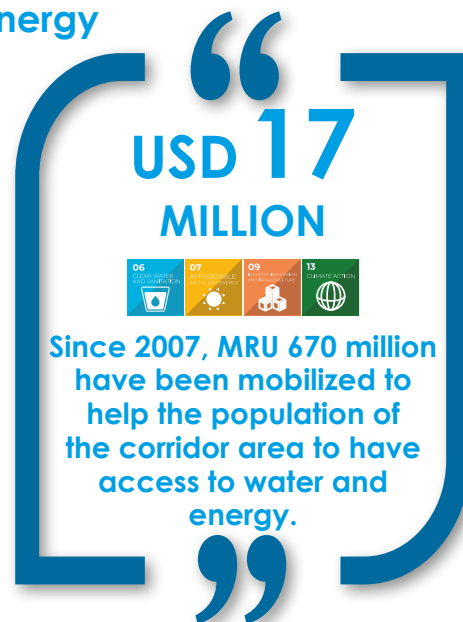
Major investments should not overshadow the importance of grassroots development actions that contribute to the fight against poverty and precarity, such as the cooperative shops in Leghreidatt, Inal, Tmeimchatt, and Ben Amera.

Support for access to water and energy

• Access to water

Water stress is one of the major constraints that Mauritania must address. According to the SDGs dashboard, Goal 6 (Clean Water and Sanitation) indicates that the country faces significant challenges in achieving this objective. In this context, SNIM Foundation continues its support to the government's efforts to improve access to water, particularly in the northern zone, which suffers from low rainfall.

In 2022, support for access to water accounted for 22% of the budget, with a total of MRU 106.6 million allocated. The actions undertaken in this sector are distributed as follow :



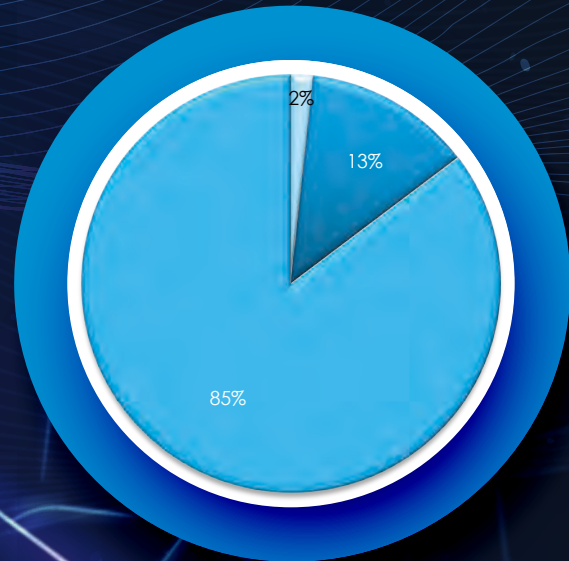

- Support for energy

With regards to SDG 7 (Access to clean and affordable energy), Mauritania faces major challenges in this area. Therefore, support for access to energy falls within the framework of SNIM's citizen

engagement through its social arm, the SNIM Foundation. In 2022, support for access to energy accounted for 9% of the budget, with a total of MRU 46.2 million allocated.

The city of Zouerate received 85% of the executed budget in 2022. Significant amounts were allocated to two projects under implementation, namely the electrification project for the 600-lot neighborhood, with a total investment of MRU 27.4 million, and the extension of

the grid in the buffer zone between the Tarhil neighborhood and the Zouerate Municipal Stadium, with an amount of MRU 12 million. These endeavors are expected to notably enhance the living standards of the populations living in these areas.

Support for education sector

The amount invested in the education sector, which stood at MRU 78 million (2.15 million USD), reflects the interest that SNIM places on the education of children from the communities neighboring its activities.

In 2022, notable initiatives included :

- The construction of 2 complete schools with 12 classrooms each in Zouerate and another in the city of Choum.
- The rehabilitation and extension of 10 schools in Nouadhibou.
- Providing educational assistance to all families of SNIM workers with school-aged children (MRU5.6 million).
- Distributing school uniforms to schools in the corridor.

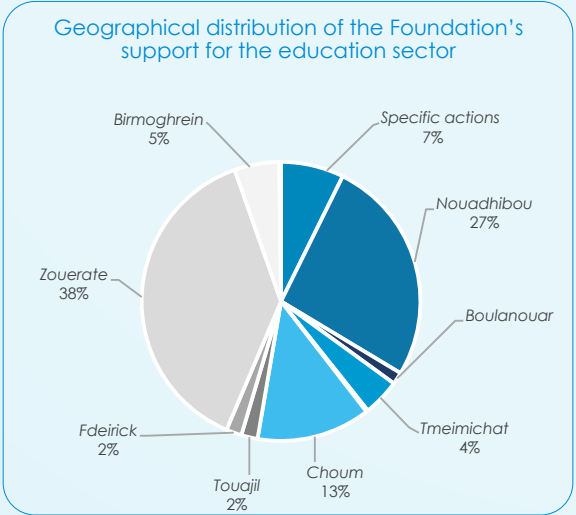
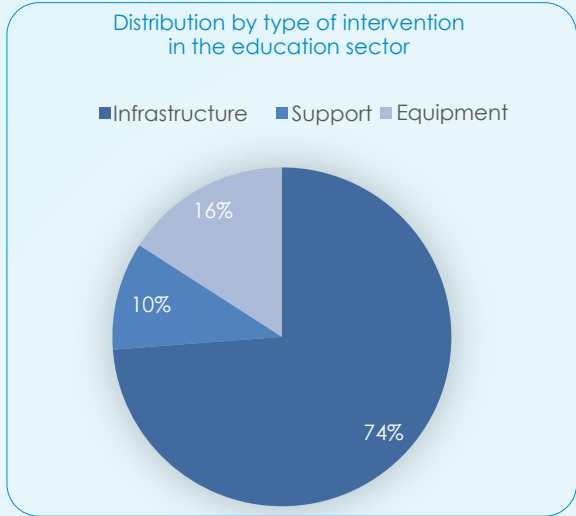

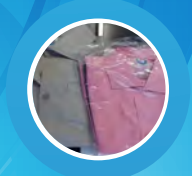

The year 2022 was marked by the construction of 4 complete schools (ground floor + first floor): one in Choum and three in Zouerate. Additionally, rehabilitation and extension works have been carried out in 12 schools (10 in Nouadhibou, 1 in Touajil, and 1 in Bir).

Support for health

The contribution of the SNIM Foundation to the health sector has been one of the major priorities of the Foundation since its creation in 2007. This commitment is aimed at strengthening the government's efforts and providing support to the population in this area to help the country progress towards SDG 3.

In 2022, health-related expenditures amounted to MRU36.9 million (approximately USD1 million), representing 7% of the SNIM Foundation's budget.

The year was particularly marked by the rehabilitation and provision of equipment to the Specialized Hospital Center in Nouadhibou, the extension and rehabilitation of the health center in Boulanouar, the extension and rehabilitation of the health center in Zouerate, as well as the provision of supplies and ambulances.

Additionally, the Foundation covers annually the CNAM (National Health Insurance Fund) contributions and health assistance for SNIM's retirees, fuel provisions for ambulances in all localities along the railway corridor, as well as bonuses and subsidies to attract and motivate medical staff operating in healthcare facilities along the corridor.

The subsidy to the operating costs of the Health Center of Zouerate and its rehabilitation, as well as the rehabilitation of the Health Center of Nouadhibou (CHSNDB), account for 66% of the health support, with a total amount of MRU23.1 million. Also, this year was marked by the affiliation saw the affiliation of 41 new SNIM's retirees to CNAM, along with various health aids distributed to this population.

Support for SNIM's retirees accounts for 50% of this amount, totaling MRU12.4 million. 43% was allocated in the form of aid and subsidies for the corridor, and 7% was allocated outside the corridor.



A training program for essential trades has been initiated in Zouerate and Nouadhibou for the benefit of 120 sons of SNIM's retirees. This program aims to integrate young people into the job market and, consequently, provide social assistance to retirees.



The establishment of a center for autistic children in Zouerate addresses the need for their education and subsequent integration into active life.



← Support and subsidies for religious institutions and activities

This sector accounted for 5% of the budget, with a total amount of MRU 24.6 million. It was primarily marked by the following activities :

- Refurbishment of 6 mosques in Nouadhibou and 6 mosques in Zouerate, totaling MRU12.8 million.
- Construction of a mosque in Zouerate, costing MRU3.8 million.
- Construction of a model Madrasa in F'derick, costing MRU2.6 million.
- Ramadan Iftar operation along the corridor, costing MRU4.9 million.
